Had also worked on assignments for – Commonwealth Fund for Technical Cooperation, United Nations, World Bank, Asian Development Bank and the Arab Monetary Fund. Major countries covered included: Russia, Kazakhstan, China, Iraq, Jordan, Palestine, Egypt, Papua New Guinea in the South Pacific and Tanzania and Namibia in Africa.
