ABSTRACT

The paper seeks to explore the interrelationships between corporate governance (CG) and corporate social responsibility (CSR): firstly, theoretically, by reviewing the literature and surveying various postulations on offer; secondly, empirically, by investigating the conception and interpretation of this relationship in the context of a sample of companies operating in India. Accordingly, the paper also seeks to highlight the increasing cross-connects or interfaces between CG and CSR, capitalizing on fresh insights from a developing country perspective.
