Admission to M.B.A. Programs: Academic Year 2025-26

Applications are invited for admission to the 2-year M.B.A. programs in

(i) Business Analytics; (ii) Finance

Awarded by the Madras School of Economics under its degree-granting power as per MSE Act 2020.

Eligibility

- a) **Academic Qualifications:** Applicants must have completed their undergraduate studies in social sciences (including commerce & management), sciences, mathematics, statistics, or engineering in their first attempt. Final-year undergraduate students appearing for their exams in May 2025 are also eligible. Additionally, candidates must have secured a minimum of 60% marks in Class X, and XII.
- b) **Minimum Percentage Requirements at the Undergraduate Level:** A minimum of 55% for General category, 50% for OBC – Non-Creamy Layer, and 45% for SC/ST/PWD candidates is required.
- c) **Age Limit:** Candidates should not be older than 25 years as of July 1, 2025.
- d) **Mathematics Requirement:** Candidates should have studied Mathematics at the Class XII level or an equivalent qualification. This includes a pass certificate from the National Institute of Open Schooling (Senior Secondary Level Mathematics) or completion of mathematical economics courses at the undergraduate level, covering topics such as Linear Algebra, Differential Calculus (single & multivariable), and Optimization (Linear & Non-linear).
- e) **Additional Requirements:** Candidates must hold an undergraduate degree from a recognized university under the 10+2+3 or 10+2+4 system and must not have any arrears or backlogs at the time of joining the program. Additionally, they must have valid scores from any of the following entrance exams: CAT, GMAT, XAT, MAT, CMAT, or ATMA.

Number of Seats

The intake for each of the M.B.A. Programs will be 47, including a 35% quota for the resident students of Tamil Nadu. Reservation Policy of Government of Tamil Nadu will be followed.

Application and Basis of Selection

Candidates will be shortlisted based on their performance in the standardized tests (both overall and sectional cut-off scores). The overall and sectional cut-offs for each entrance exam is decided by the admission committee, which will meet after the application deadline.
